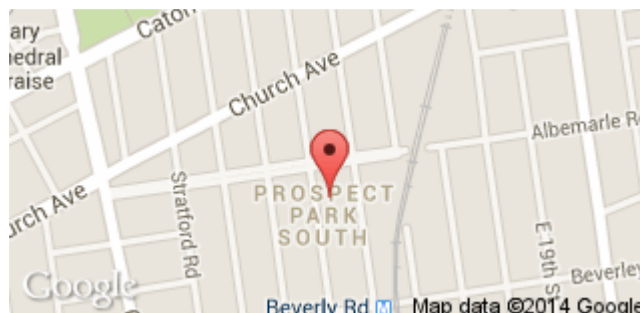
Single Family Townhouse :: Kensington

As if that was not enough, there is another sun room at that back of the house that looks out onto the garden, and a recently renovated powder room. On the second floor are four large bedrooms and 3 full baths and on the third floor an additional three bedrooms and one full bath.
