

297 6th Street

Multi-Family Townhouse Block & Lot 987-60 Park Slope



Built in 1891 by developer and architect Ervin G. Gollner, 297 Sixth Street sits in the middle of a quiet tree-lined Park Slope block. The façade of this brick and brownstone Queen Anne townhouse is graced with an elegant two-story angled bay with classically inspired pressed metal columns. There is a garden level 1-bedroom apartment, and a 3-bedroom, 2-bath duplex, both of which have large decks perched above the garden, which is tranquil and sunny. The current owners renovated the house in the 1990s with new electric, plumbing, and other improvements, while maintaining much of the original detail. The garden level kitchen, which is open and bright, was fully renovated in 2012.
