**Cellar:** Full dry basement. Ceiling height 5'10". Great storage. Laundry.

**Garden:** Currently lower level of owners' duplex. Formal dining room with decorative fireplace has pass-through to efficient galley kitchen with pantry. Sun-filled living room with fireplace. Exposed brick wall. Built-in bookcases. Hardwood floors. French doors open onto south facing garden filled with mature plantings.

**Parlor:** Interior stairs from garden level lead to upper level of owners' duplex. Two south facing bedrooms overlook lush garden. Two full hall baths. Grand master bedroom occupies parlor with original double doors intact. Lovely mantel. Over 11' ceiling height. Built-in storage/closets. Ornate grillwork adds period detail.
