Cellar: Windowed in front and back of the house. Windowed maid's room with full bath. Laundry room. Wood shop. State of the art mechanicals. Radiant heat floors throughout.

Garden Floor: Bedroom with en suite bath. Dining Room, Chef's Kitchen. Sunroom. Access to garden from two separate entrances. Terra cotta floors throughout with radiant heat beneath them.

Second Floor: Soaring Ceilings. Music room, (possible formal dining room and roughing in place for wet bar). Elegant vestibule with custom lighting highlighting sculptural staircase and custom designed entry doors. Formal Living Room with wood-burning fireplace. Garden-facing loggia.

Third Floor: Master bedroom and second bedroom. Large, luxurious master bath with steam shower and large soaking tub. Master bedroom is in the rear, has a woodburning fireplace and has a study in the extension.

Fourth Floor: Two Full Bedrooms with en suite baths. Rear bedroom has wood-burning fireplace and large terrace.

Fifth Floor: Ceilings soaring up to 13 feet. Two Full Bedrooms and with two en suite baths possible on this level or guest apartment with separate kitchen. Wood-burning fireplace in rear bedroom. 8x4 skylights in both rooms.

Roof: Straight set of stairs leads up to bulkhead. Steel Framing of building allows for easy construction of penthouse if desired.
