Central Park South is one of the great boulevards of Manhattan, anchoring the southern edge of Frederick Law Olmsted's 1873 masterpiece of urban landscape design. Here, at the heart of the city—where fashion, art, commerce, theater, history and nature intersect—this landmarked pre-war condominium rises gracefully from its distinguished parkside setting. The six floor-through residences and dazzling duplex penthouse exude quiet luxury and a rare sense of privacy, technologically enhanced by a customized Crestron home automation system.

THE VIEW


he floor-to-ceiling windows in the Great Rooms of 22 Central Park South frame majestic vistas of Central Park as far as the eye can see. The scene transforms dramatically as the seasons change, providing a movable feast of form, color, light and texture. Iconic New York buildings to the east and west appear like architectural guardians, as if watching over the treasures of Central Park.














THE LOBBY

n elegant glass and wrought iron door punctuates the restrained limestone façade of 22 Central Park South, granting discreet access to the residences and penthouse. Amidst the understated grandeur of a hand-laid marble mosaic floor and a stunning chandelier, residents and their guests are warmly welcomed by the concierge before ascending to one of only seven beautifully conceived and executed condominium homes.





THE GREAT ROOM

onoring the design tradition of New York's famed pre-war apartment houses, 22 Central Park South has reinterpreted the classic drawing room for a new, forward-looking generation. A clean, modern aesthetic defines this important living space, giving prominence to the Central Park view while paying close attention to the details, such as a decorative fireplace, wrought iron Juliet balcony detail, radiant floor heating, solid walnut herringbone pattern floors, and oversized casement windows. A sophisticated contemporary interior is as much about the "little" things as it is about the grand gestures.








THE KITCHEN




CENTRAL PARK SOUTH

























THE DUPLEX PENTHOUSE

The largest terrace overlooks Central Park, while another terrace adjoining the Library includes a Kallista Monte Carlo wetbar and a U-Line 24" under-counter refrigerator, creating a private oasis for entertaining or quiet contemplation.
